**TERMS AND CONDITIONS**

**Terms and conditions associated with the listing of, or removal of woodpiles listed in the Lincoln County Woodpile Program. All terms listed herein will be read, understood, and adhered to as a condition of participation in this program.**

**The South Central Mountain RC&D makes no guarantee as to the accuracy of information listed in the Woodpile Program, including but not limited to the location, presence, quality, defects, or other hazards associated with the removal, transportation, or utilization of woody material.**

**TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR LANDOWNERS SUBMITTING WOODPILE LOCATIONS TO THE PROGRAM AND FOR ANYONE PICKING UP WOOD FROM PUBLICISED LOCATIONS:**

**I understand this program creates a forum to connect landowners wishing to get rid of their wood, with people who are willing to come and pick it up for free. Central Mountain RC&D is not responsible for the actions of private individuals or the public associated with the removal of woodpiles, does not guarantee your woodpile will be removed, and only serves to disseminate submitted information.**

**I have cut my wood into 18” lengths and have stacked it at the roadside unless otherwise noted.**

**I understand my woodpile and name will be publicized in the Lincoln County Woodpile section of the Ruidoso Free Press. Example; *“123 Main Street, Alto NM- woodpile – pine – approx 3 truckloads – Smith”***

**I will obey all laws concerned with the transfer of woody material from private property. My program application represents written consent for the public to transport wood from my property in accordance with New Mexico State Law (68-2-22). I will provide written consent to anyone removing wood from my property.**

**I will obey all laws concerned with the removal and transfer of woody material from properties participating in this program. The Lincoln County Woodpile section in the Ruidoso Free Press represents written consent to remove and transport wood from private property in accordance with New Mexico State Law (68-2-22). I will acquire written consent from the landowner prior to the removal of wood from private property.**

**I will only remove woody material that is cut and stacked along the roadside of properties where woodpiles have been listed. I will not cut any wood while removing material from woodpiles listed in this program.**

**I will follow manufactures recommendations associated with transporting, utilizing, and or burning wood. I understand wood has pitch and if burned in a woodstove or fireplace I must clean my chimney regularly.**
